St. Gregory's typically leads a summer trip for high school youth. All Youth from the Diocese are invited!

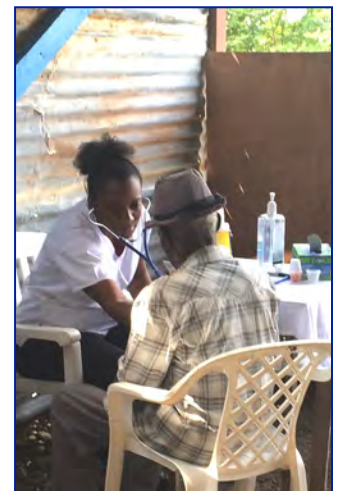


## Mission Trips...
